## NOTICE OF REPRESENTATION PERIOD FOR THE RESERVE HOUSING SITES

As the next stage in preparing the planning strategy for Horsham District to 2018, Horsham District Council is publishing the Reserve Housing Sites document for consultation. Once agreed, the Reserve Housing Sites document will identify additional land for housing in the most sustainable locations, to be held in reserve in case the Council is unable to meet its short to medium term housing requirements.

This document is at the 'Preferred Options' stage and will be published for a six week consultation period on 6 June 2008. Any comments submitted, which must be received by **4.20pm on 18 July 2008**, will be analysed and considered in the next stage of the Local Development Framework process.
